The Protected Zone Joint Authority intends to do the following act:

TYPE OF APPROVAL	Variation of licence conditions applicable to commercial fishing in the Torres Strait Prawn Fishery within the Protected Zone and adjacent waters.
NUMBER OF APPROVALS	All fishing boat licences within the Torres Strait Prawn fishery (60 licences).
UNDER WHAT ACT	The Torres Strait Fisheries Act 1984 (the Act).

The approvals, if granted, will permit the following activity to happen:

NATURE OF ACTIVITY	Under subsection 22(1) of the Act a licence granted under section 19 is subject to conditions specified on the licence.
	Subsection 22(2) allows the Minister (or a delegate) to vary or revoke the conditions of the licence or specify further conditions to which the licence is subject to.
	The proposed management action would vary the licence conditions for the Torres Strait Prawn Fishery licence holders. The only change is to clarify that licence holders can only fish for species they are authorised to fish for as indicated by the symbols noted on their licence. This change was implemented for all other Torres Strait fisheries in late 2022.

Background Information

The Australian Fisheries Management Authority (AFMA) provides licensing functions on behalf of the Protected Zone Joint Authority (PZJA). The licences that AFMA issues are subject to conditions under section 22 of the *Torres Strait Fisheries Act 1984*. Current licence conditions have been developed over many years and therefore it is appropriate that AFMA periodically review the management arrangements and licence conditions that apply to a fishery to ensure they are fit for purpose, meet the legislative objectives of the fishery, achieve the policy intent and remain enforceable.

AFMA proposes to vary one licence condition applicable to the Torres Strait Prawn Fishery, to clarify that licence holders can only take, process or carry species they are authorised to as indicated by the symbols noted on their licence.

The varied condition is expected to help ensure that all requirements of a licence are clear to TSPF licence holders. This condition was introduced for all other Torres Strait fisheries and licence holders (including Traditional Inhabitant Boat Licence and IB and carrier boat licences) in late 2022. Further consultation was required with the TSPF before bringing the same licence condition into this fishery.

What are the proposed condition changes?

This condition change seeks to clarify that a licence holder can only take, process or carry certain fish in a certain area of fishery waters (as indicated by a fishery symbol on the licence e.g. PR for the Torres Strait Prawn Fishery). Licence holders should already be familiar with what the fishery symbols on their licences mean. This condition variation merely provides greater clarity and seeks to remove any possible ambiguity in language.

What impact will the conditions have on Traditional Inhabitants?

This change will not directly affect Traditional Inhabitant Boat (TIB) licence holders, as there are no TIB licences with TSPF PR symbols.
